Backpack in for trail work

For the trail work to be performed on the Silverton Double Dirty 30 race course we MAY have the option of sending a group or two out on a backpack trail work trip. We would head out Saturday morning with the rest of the crews, but we would come with our backpacks packed and ready to camp out for the night. We would camp somewhere between the junction of the Colorado Trail and the Engineer Mountain Trail and the Engineer Mountain Trail and the White Trail.
