

Hardrock Service Requirement Certification

The Hardrock Hundred has a service requirement for all starters. This can be satisfied by performing eight hours of work in either

- 1) organization of an ultra,
- 2) service at an ultra (e.g., working an aid station),
- 3) work on a trail used by an ultra.

Note that generic trail work is not acceptable - it must be a trail on which an ultra is run, and must be coordinated with the Race Director of that ultra. Pacing or crewing another runner at an ultra does not count.

The window for performing this work began July 1, 2021 and ends on June 12, 2022. **This form must be received by the Hardrock Run Committee no later than June 19, 2022**, and must be signed by the Race Director of the ultra which you supported. On June 20, runners who have not turned in their form will be removed from the start list and wait list. **Thus, runners who wish to remain on the wait list must also return their Service Form by June 19, 2022.**

After completion, this form should be scanned or photographed and emailed to Hardrock Lottery Coordinator Blake Wood, blake@hardrock100.com. Please put the name of the runner in the subject line, as in **"Hardrock Service Form for John Doe"**, so it doesn't end up in my spam folder.
